



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# DAILY DEBRIEF

Date:

In our last unit (unit 3: European Exploration) we discussed the arrival of the Spanish in the New World, and their interactions with the Native Americans. This week we will discuss English settlement in the Thirteen Colonies. Keep a critical eye out for <u>who</u> was moving to the colonies and <u>why</u> they were moving there in the first place. What did these settlers hope to achieve? What was life like in the early days of the colonies? These are the questions we will answer this week in our **fourth** unit: Colonization and Settlement.

**<u>Pilgrim:</u>** An English person who landed in Plymouth, Massachusetts to escape religious persecution. Arrived in 1620

**Puritan:** An English person who colonized New England to escape religious persecution. Arrived in 1629

There are several facts you should know about New England:

- The two colonies in Massachusetts—Plymouth (\_\_\_\_\_\_) and the Massachusetts Bay Colony (\_\_\_\_\_\_)—came for religious freedom. However, these groups did not tolerate different religions in their colony.
